DAY ONE - EN ROUTE/ST. LOUIS

Most Michigan participants will depart this morning on Amtrak's Wolverine from Dearborn, Ann Arbor, Jackson, Battle Creek or Kalamazoo.

The Tour Director will meet those departing from Dearborn and be on board the Wolverine when it arrives at the other stops. Arrival into Chicago is scheduled for 11:24 a.m.

Port Huron, Lapeer, Flint, Durand, Lansing, Niles and New Buffalo tour members will travel on the Blue Water to Chicago where they'll arrive at 11:59 a.m.

West Michigan travelers will depart on the Pere Marquette from Grand Rapids, Holland and St. Joseph this morning and arrive in Chicago at 10:33 a.m. An America by Rail representative will greet them upon arrival in Chicago.

Relax in your comfortable reclining coach seat. Stroll to the lounge car for beverages, sandwiches and snacks. Watch the picturesque southwest Michigan landscape pass by your wide train window. There will be time for an "on-your-own" lunch in Chicago.

At 1:15 p.m. we'll board the Texas Eagle for the 280-mile journey to St. Louis. Departure is at 1:45. Sandwiches, snacks and beverages are available in the lounge car. A full-course dining car dinner is included this evening.

Our arrival into St. Louis is scheduled for 7:35 p.m. We'll transfer the short distance to the Holiday Inn Southwest.

DAY TWO - BRANSON

Breakfast is included in our hotel this morning.

DAY SIX - EN ROUTE

Following a Continental breakfast (included), we’ll transfer to the Springfield Amtrak station where, at 6:33 a.m., we’ll board a Lincoln Service Train for Chicago. Snacks and beverages are available in the lounge car. Our arrival into Chicago’s Union Station is scheduled for 10:00 a.m.

At 12:15 p.m. most Michigan tour members will depart on Amtrak’s Wolverine and arrive at Niles, Kalamazoo, Battle Creek, Jackson, Ann Arbor and Dearborn throughout the afternoon and early evening.

New Buffalo, Lansing, Durand, Flint, Lapeer, and Port Huron travelers will depart on the Blue Water at 4:10 p.m. and arrive home throughout the evening.

West Michigan travelers bound for St. Joseph, Holland and Grand Rapids will depart from Chicago on the Pere Marquette at 5:20 p.m. They will arrive home throughout the evening. **CB**
